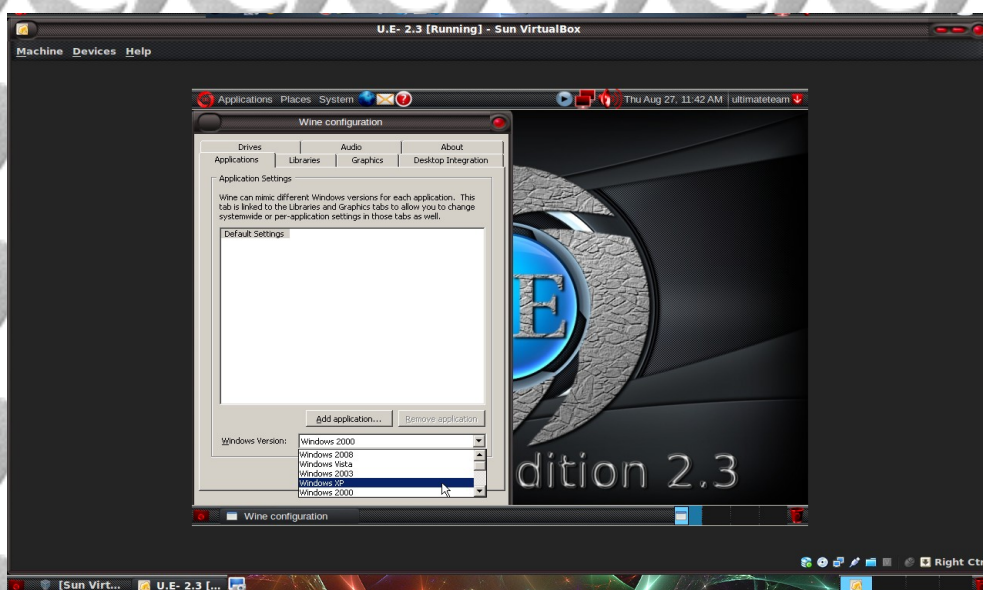


## *Configuring Wine*

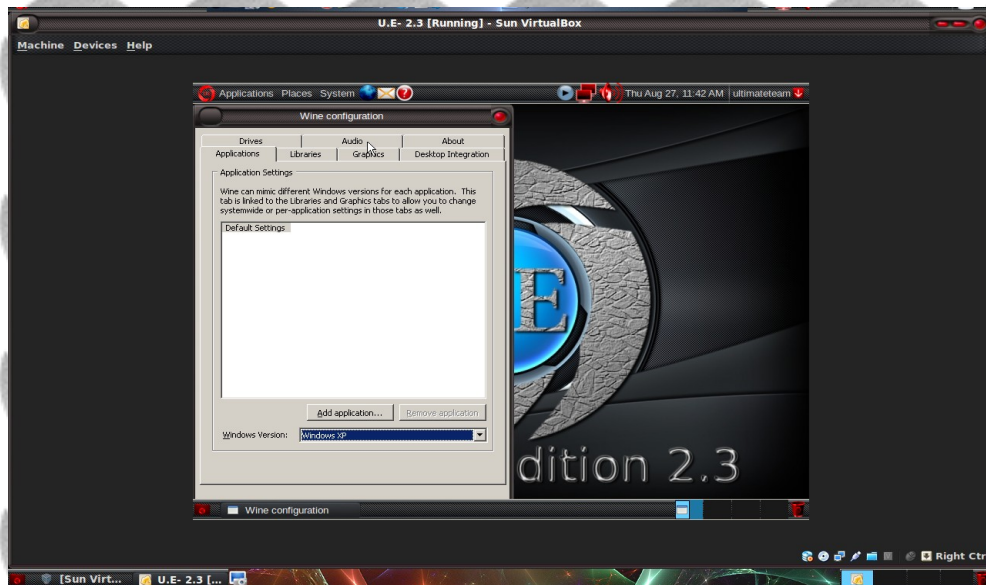
*Wine is actually a Windows compatibility layer that allows you to run MS-Windows softwares on Linux machines. It is done by mimicking most of the windows system calls, registry calls, etc to the linux machine/kernel. As per now most of the Windows programs run smoothly through Wine. Here we tell you some basic configurations for Wine which should make your experience with Wine a pleasure. Keep reading...*



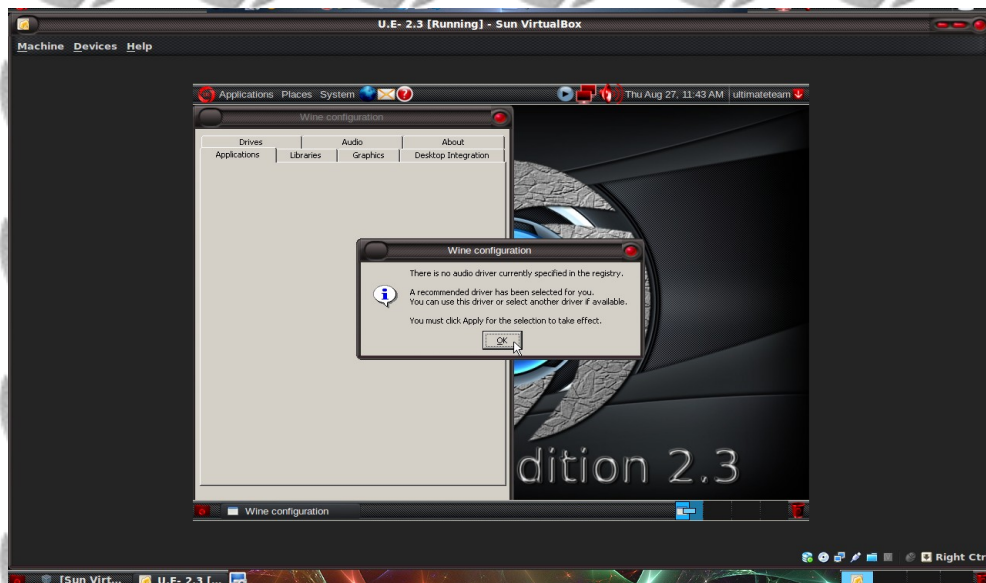
*Select Menu > Wine > Configure Wine*



*Under Applications in Wine configuration window select "Windows XP". This is compatibility mode for Wine*



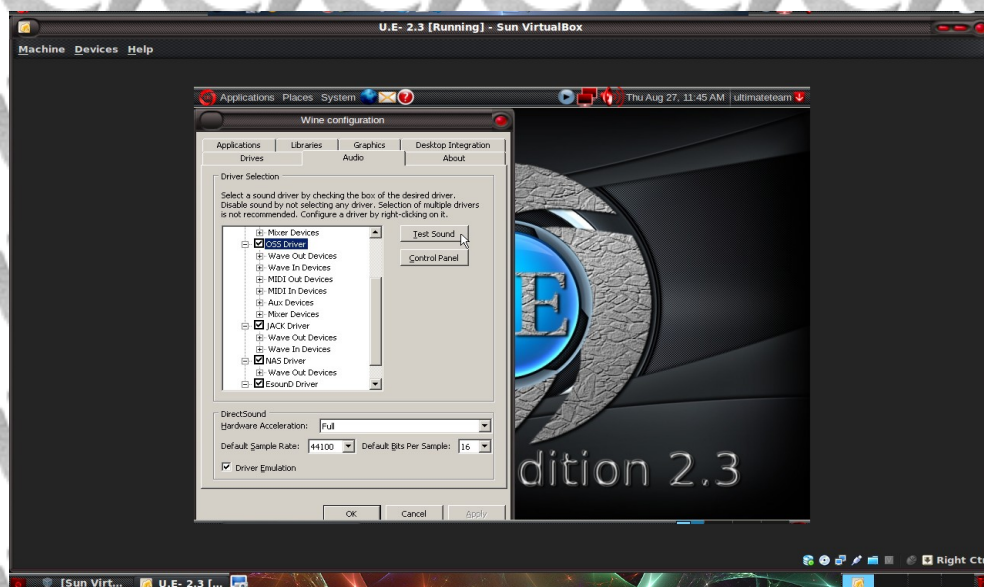
*Now select Audio tab to configure Audio for Wine*



*Wine will show you information that it has selected the driver for your audio. Click OK.*



*Now select all the options in audio tab*



*Finally test sound by click on “Test Sound”. In case you hear no audio or distortion uncheck one of the option and again test sound. You can repeat this process untill sound is just perfect for you.*

*Finally click OK to save your settings and exit Wine configuration window.*
